

Religious Education Non-Catechist Volunteer Opportunities 2012-2013

Teacher Assistant:

Assistant teachers are needed to assist during the 2012-2013 school year for children ages 3 years through 5th grade. Classes meet on Sundays from September through May. We offer three different RE class times: 9:45 am - 11:00 am, 11:15 am - 12:30 pm; and 4:00 pm – 5:15 pm. No prior Religious Education teaching experience is necessary, just the love of our faith and desire to share it with the children in our parish.

Teacher Substitute:

Substitute teachers are needed to assist during the 2012-2013 school year for children ages 3 years through 5th grade. Classes meet on Sundays from September through May. We offer three different RE class times: 9:45 am - 11:00 am, 11:15 am - 12:30 pm; and 4:00 pm – 5:15 pm. EDGE Core Members:

Adults are needed to assist middle-school students (grades 6th – 8th) in spiritual, educational, service and social activities throughout the year. EDGE is on Sundays from 4:00 pm – 5:15 pm.

Vacation Bible School:

Vacation Bible School is held each summer. We need many volunteers to help ensure a successful program. Volunteer to help with the pre-planning or just during the actual week.

Grade Level Social Events:

Help coordinate a social event for your child's class or grade. This could be a pizza party, skate night, pool party or Mass and dinner etc.

Sacramental Volunteers:

We need many volunteers on the day of the Sacraments (First Penance, First Holy Communion and Confirmation). Volunteer to help with the logistics of making this day run smoothly for Sacramental candidates and their families.

Reception Volunteers:

We need additional volunteers to help with several receptions we have throughout the year in honor of our Religious Education students receiving a Sacrament.

Clergy Appreciation:

Each class will have the opportunity to show their appreciation for our wonderful clergy. This may be at their birthday or Lent and Advent. Each class/grade will be assigned a clergy member by the Religious Education Department. We need volunteers to help coordinate class/grade efforts.

Resource/Bulletin Board Coordinator:

We support our Catechists with supplies, resources and shared bulletin boards to display the children's work. We need you to help keep up with this on a rotating basis.
